WHAT IS THIS HEARING ABOUT?

Dynegy Midwest Generation has applied for Section 401 Water Quality Certification for impacts associated with a riverbank stabilization project. This includes placing over 22,000 cubic yards of rip-rap and other fill along 2,000 linear feet of the right descending bank of the Middle Fork.

This massive project will harm the river. Approval by the Illinois EPA will set the stage for Dynegy to be able to cap its toxic waste and permanently leave it in the floodplain of Illinois' only National Scenic River.

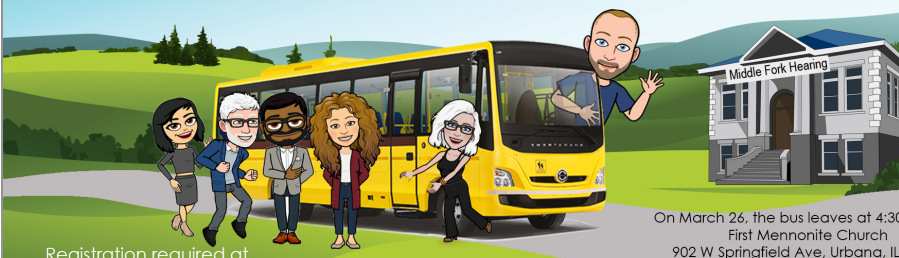
